DAR Outstanding Cadet Medal

The DAR Outstanding Cadet Medal is awarded to a cadet of outstanding ability and achievement in a non-ROTC, military-affiliated cadet program funded by a school or privately or to cadets in police, fire, and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) volunteer cadet training programs.

Eligible programs include, but are not limited to, Naval Sea Cadet Corps; Civil Air Patrol; National Defense Cadet Corps (NDCC); American Cadet Alliance (ACA); Young Marines; National Middle School Cadet Corps (NMSCC); U. S. Navy League Cadet Corps; Joint Military Cadets of America (JMCA); United States Cadet Corps; or to police, fire, or EMS cadets (one medal per year per cadet unit.) Recipients must have distinguished themselves through outstanding leadership, honor, service, courage, and patriotism. May be awarded to a male or female cadet.
