Participation Guidelines

- Membership is based on the NSDAR Fiscal Year, from March 1 to the last day of February.
- Members may purchase the 1890 Annual Giving Circle Pin from J. E. Caldwell & Co. when they reach the Topaz level.
- Members may purchase the 1890 Annual Giving Pin Bars annually. The bar will reflect the member's giving level.
- All donations to the general fund qualify including donations made through the direct mail program.

Benefits and Privileges

- A gift, signed by the President General


Sapphire (\$10,000 to \$24,999)
