



Educational Programs

The Daughters of the American Revolution is a non-profit, non-political volunteer women's service organization. DAR members are dedicated to promoting historic preservation, education and patriotism in communities across the nation. All students are invited to participate and learn more about the educational programs the DAR offers. Educators, parents and students are encouraged to contact their local DAR chapters for more detailed information on programs provided in their community which may include:

Historic Preservation

- **American History Essay Contest** - Annual essay contest established to encourage young people to think creatively about American History.
- **Christopher Columbus Essay Contest** - Annual essay contest held to honor Christopher Columbus.
- **DAR Historic Sites** - Database catalogues information about historic properties that are owned or maintained by DAR chapters or state societies.

Education

- **Constitution Week** - The week-long annual celebration of the US Constitution was established by the DAR in 1956.
- **Junior American Citizens** - All students are invited to get involved in this program that promotes good citizenship and appreciation of American history.
- **Scholarships** - Open to all students, the DAR offers numerous scholarships for a large variety of different programs and areas of study.

Patriotism

- **DAR Good Citizens Award and Scholarship** - An award and possible scholarship opportunity for high school seniors who possess the qualities of good citizenship.
- **DAR Manual for Citizenship** - First compiled in 1921 and updated over time, the DAR provides this online manual to assist those individuals becoming naturalized citizens.
- **Flags and the Flag Code** - The US Flag Code is a useful tool for students studying the US Flag.
- **Good Citizenship Medal** - Medals given to students who exemplify the duties of good citizenship.
- **ROTC Medals** - Awards given to student cadets for their dedication to their ROTC programs.
