

This engraving was copied by A.H. Ritchie from an oil painting by F.B. Carpenter. Engraving and printing was a quicker way to get copies of art to people than making hundreds of oil paintings! This scene is meant to commemorate Lincoln reading the first draft of the Emancipation Proclamation to his cabinet (his advisors and leaders in the government). During the American Civil War, this complex legal document helped forward progress towards ending chattel slavery in the United States. Instead of being property, Lincoln promised that enslaved Americans would be "forever free." #99.9
