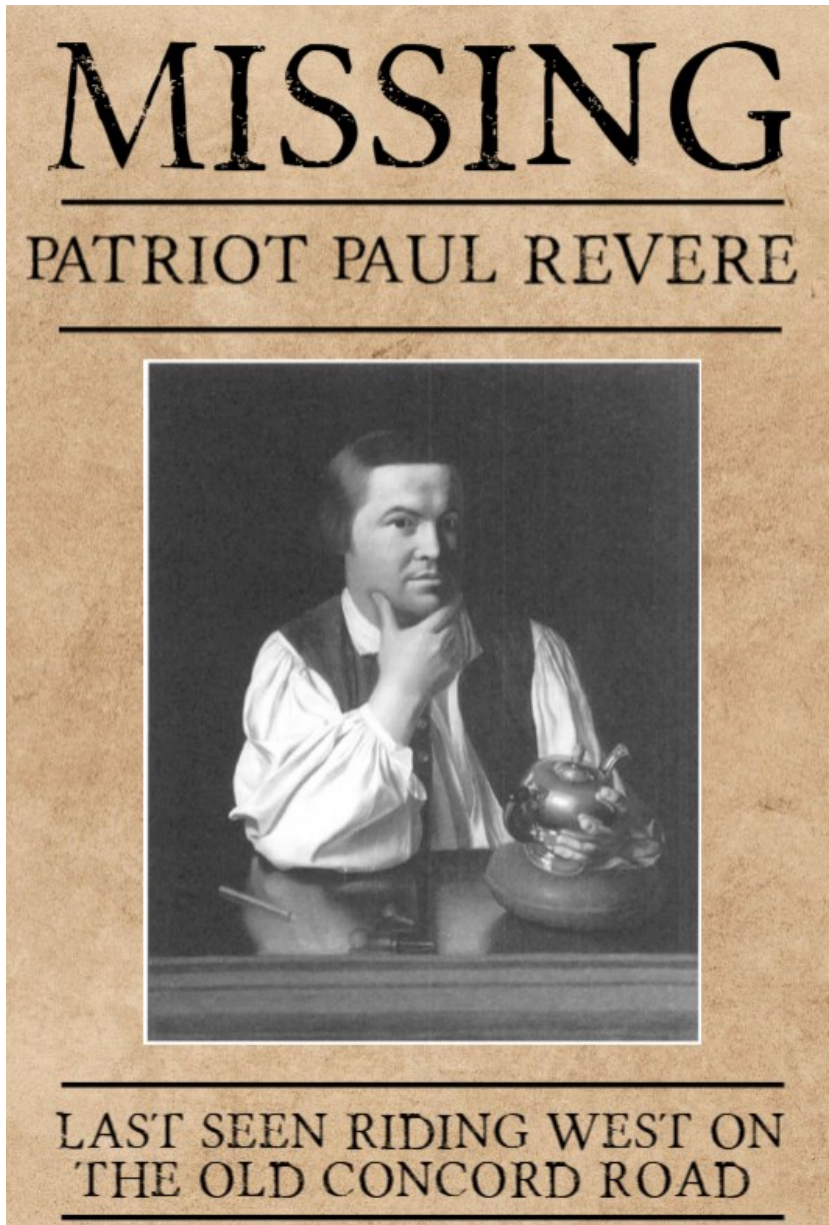

and his allies' ride.

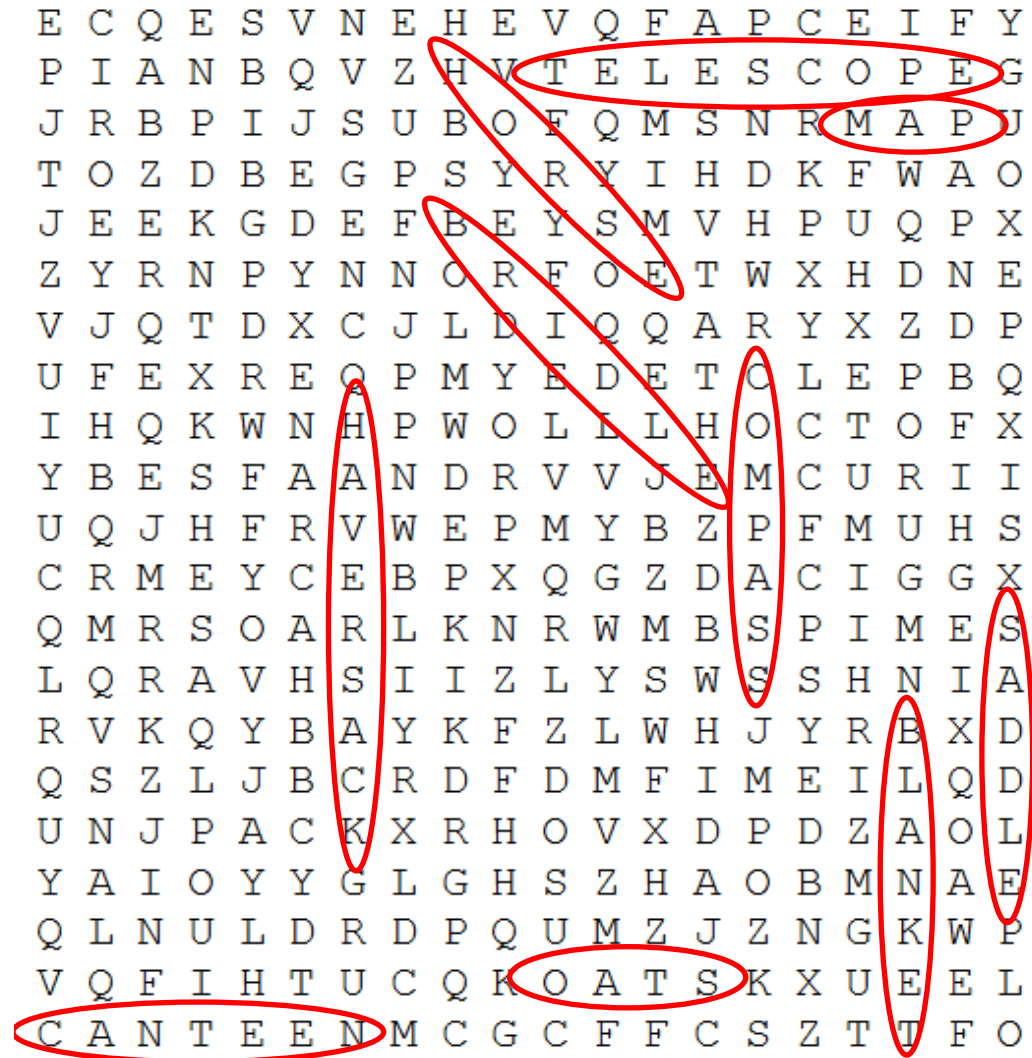

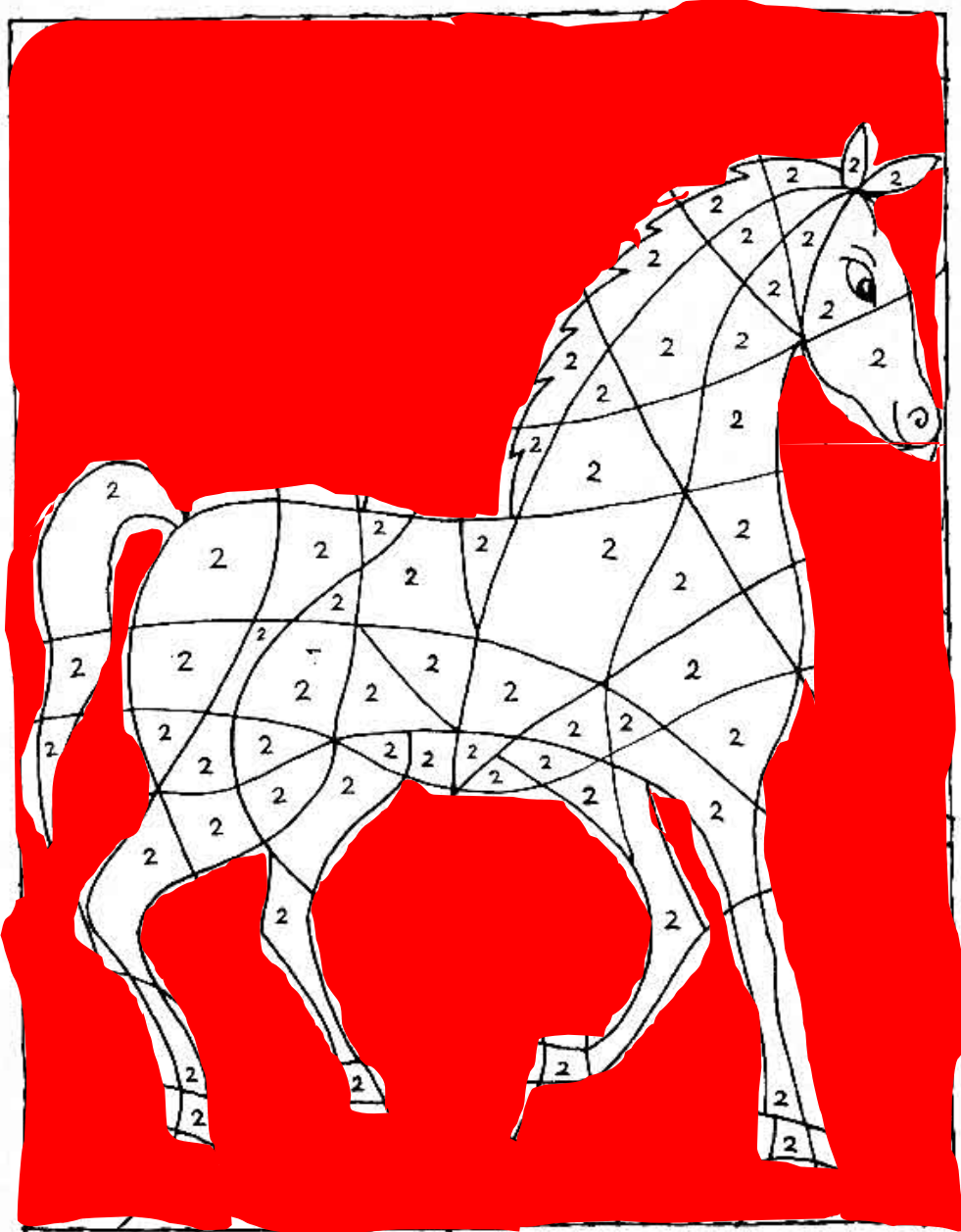
