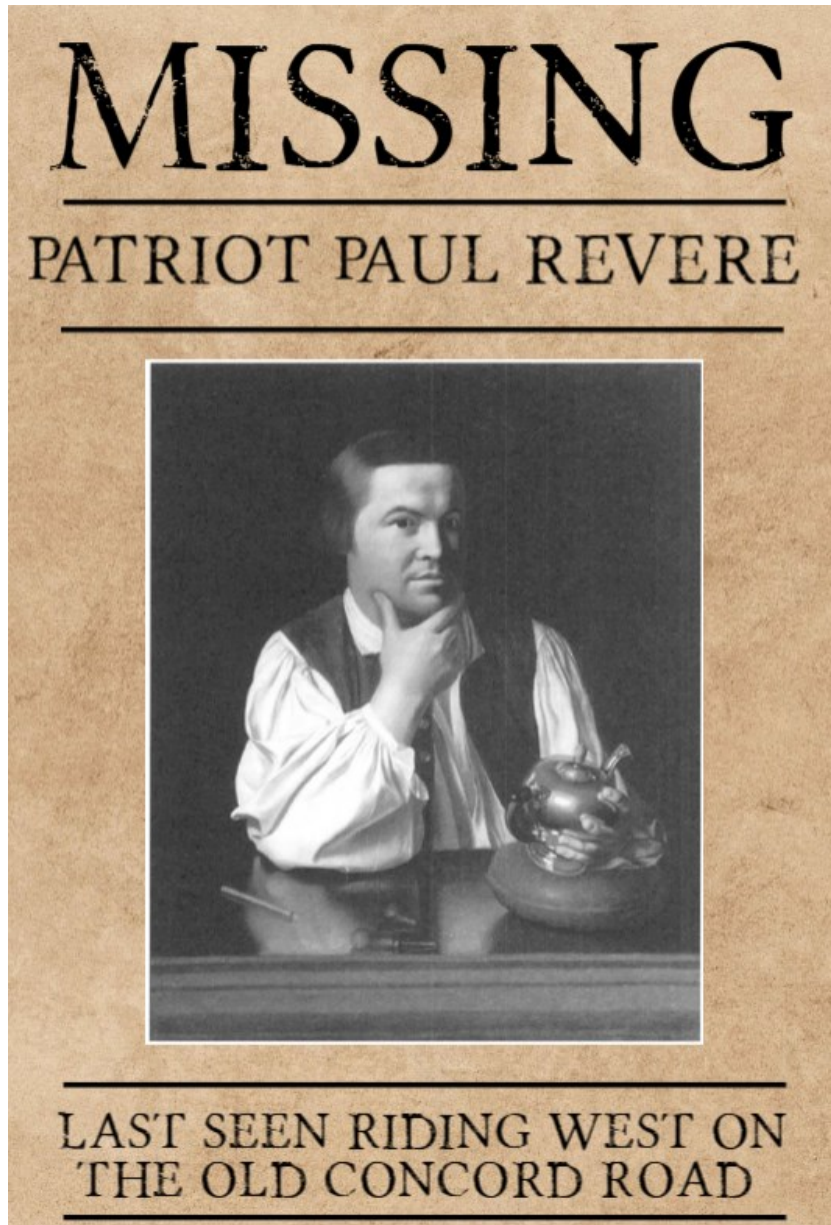
**PATRIOTS**
