A pending life member, Morgan is currently honored to serve as NVC, Volunteer Genealogists Committee, as a member of the Lineage Research Committee, Region III, and as VAVS Representative, Metro Phoenix.

Her past service includes representing the Arizona Society on the National Board of Management 2020-2022, Lineage Research Committee National Chair 2016-2019, CDRC National Vice Chair 2016-2019, and as a member of the DAR America 250! Membership Taskforce 2017-2022, Continental Congress Hospitality Committee 2015-2017, Seating Committee 2022, and Balcony Volunteers 2011-2018. She attended the 2019 DAR Schools Tour, and completed the Members and Committee Leaders Courses and GEP 1-7. She has 162 Member-for-Member credits and was selected National Outstanding Volunteer Genealogist of the Year in 2016.

She is a member of the National Officers Club, National Chairmen’s Association, National Vice Chairmen’s Association, State Regents Club, State Vice Regents Club, Founders Club, Heritage Club, and is a DAR Sustaining Supporter.

State and Chapter Service:

Morgan currently serves the Arizona Society as a life member of the Board of Management, Co-Chair of the President General’s Project, and Chair of the Guest Hospitality Committee. She previously served as State Regent, 2020-2022, State Vice Regent, and State Registrar.

Her state regent's projects included raising \$40,000 for the IYA Summer Camp in Prescott, \$18,000 for the NSDAR Constitution Hall Restoration, \$8,000 for a Patriots Marker to be placed at the Arizona state capitol, and the planting of 17 ironwood trees around Arizona.

She has served as CDRC Co-Chair 2018-2020 and member 2011-2022, Insignia Committee Chair 2016-2018, Volunteer Genealogists Committee Chair 2013-2016 and Vice Chair 2012-2013, State Conference Committee Vice Chair 2018-2020, and Finance Committee Member 2018-2020. A member of the State Speakers Staff since 2017, she implemented the State Application Team 2019-2020, was an Assigned Volunteer Genealogist 2012-2015, and was honored to be Arizona's State Outstanding Volunteer Genealogist in 2013 and 2016.

Morgan serves her chapter as Registrar and Bylaws Committee Chair. Her past service includes terms as Regent, Vice Regent, and Parliamentarian; and Chair of the Genealogy Preservation, Volunteer Genealogists, Lineage Research, Membership, Insignia, Programs, Bylaws, and Vietnam 50th Commemoration Committees.
