NATIONAL SERVICE:

Nancy served as Organizing Secretary General during the Dillon Administration, 2016-2019, and as Vice President General, 2013-2016. While serving as Vice President General, she also served as National Chair of Development when the Guardian Trust Endowment and the Sustaining Supporter programs were implemented by the Young Administration. Nancy has served as National Chairman of Insignia, Genealogical Records and co-chairman of the President General's Reception Room. Attending 36 Continental Congresses, she has served as member of six Congressional Committees including, Development, Page, Credentials, Program, President General's Reception Room, and Guest Hospitality. Nancy has also served as National Vice Chairman of DAR School, Units Overseas Bermuda, Guest Hospitality, Chapter Development and Revitalization and presently, Consistency in Messaging.

STATE AND CHAPTER SERVICE:

From 2011-2013, Nancy served as Tennessee State Regent. She has also served as State First Vice Regent, State Second Vice Regent, State Organizing Secretary (four chapters organized), State Treasurer, and District Director. She has been State Chairman of eleven committees including Chapter Development and Revitalization Commission receiving Southeastern Division Award last year. At the chapter level, she serves as her Chapter Parliamentarian and has served as Chapter Regent, Recording Secretary, and Registrar. She was named State Outstanding Junior while serving as State Treasurer. She is past C.A.R. Senior State Corresponding Secretary and Registrar. This year, she was recognized with the nationally venerated "Woman in American History" award.

A native Tennessean, Nancy grew up in Nashville, attending Vanderbilt University (Peabody College). She met Geoff Hemmrich on a blind date at a Vanderbilt/Tennessee football game. They married while Nancy was a college Junior and moved to Wichita, KS where Geoff was

stationed as an Air Force Officer. She continued her education and received a BA degree from Wichita State University. After a three-year tour of duty in Japan, the Hemmricks returned to the Nashville area, where Nancy was Secretary/Treasurer of the family business, Hemmrich and Associates. Geoff Hemmrich died unexpectedly in 2004 and she closed their business in 2005. Her many volunteer activities include have included active leadership roles in six other hereditary organizations, Stephen Minister, church bereavement and communion committees, Vietnam medivac center volunteer and children's schools' volunteer. Nancy is mother to two DAR daughters, Lee Hunt and Susan Flanagan, and grandmother to Geoffrey and Mimi.
