Second, she raised \$20,000 in the six-month "Project Pinecone" campaign, which will result in the reforestation of over a square mile of badly burned Idaho forest. During her time as Chapter Regent, she designed a program that donates pocket constitutions to local 5<sup>th</sup>-grade students and has personally given her "What it Means to be a Patriot" presentation to over 1,200 children.
