The State Regent's Project collaborated with other state societies placing a total of 13 new markers in three different states. Five America 250! Markers placed in Nebraska. The legacy of 18 Revolutionary War patriots were preserved with markers in Apollo, Pennsylvania. A marker placed in Milford, Pennsylvania honored the patriot ancestor of Nebraska's Organizing Regent. Another collaborative project replaced the marker of a Real Daughter from Missouri that had been lost to vandalism. Other projects recognized living veterans, created an investment

committee, implemented online registrations for state meetings, and established a DAR Good Citizens scholarship fund.
