### **National Service**

Mrs. Blair's dedication to and interest in her family history and DAR began when she completed a project which proved six generations of her family lived in her Indiana county. Mrs. Blair first served the National Society as a Continental Congress delegate. She served as East Central Vice Chair of Volunteer Genealogists (2016-2019). Currently, she serves on the National Board of Management as Indiana State Regent (2018-2021). She continues her commitment as a Sustaining Supporter Charter member, President General's Benefactor, Guardian Trust donor, and Life Member. She is a life member of the State Regents Club, the Vice Regents Club and the National Officers Club. Mrs. Blair served as the secretary of the Vice Regent's Club (2016-2017). She participated in the NSDAR School Bus tour in 2019 and has toured Hillside School.

### **State and Local Service**

Mrs. Blair has provided continuous service to Indiana DAR serving as Northern District Director (2009-2012), State Registrar (2012-2015), State Vice Regent (2015-2018), and State Regent (2018-2021). Her State Regent's Project funded the restoration of the Indiana Box and Seal in Constitution Hall, and the redesign and upgrading of the Indiana State website. Her service to the State included being committee chair of Commemorative Events, Awards, New Horizons, and Chapter Development and Revitalization Commission.
