National Service

The seeds for Mrs. Blair's national service were planted when she was Miss Stone, a Kentucky sixth grader who competed and won the DAR History Essay Contest sponsored by the local chapter. Mrs. Blair first served the national society as a Delegate to Continental Congress, as a Sustaining Supporter Charter Member and then as the NE Division Vice Chair DAR Museum Outreach. Later, after both of her daughters became members, Mrs. Blair joined the National Board of Management, took part in the NSDAR National School Bus Tour and assumed a Co-Chairmanship for the National Hillside School Tour. Currently, Mrs. Blair is an Advisor to 2020 Boston Massacre Event and the NSDAR National Chair Constitution Week.

Mrs. Blair has stayed active in NSDAR through continuous service to Massachusetts via several state offices including State Organizing Secretary, State Vice Regent, State Regent and Honorary State Regent.
