### **National Service**

Terry Lynn Clark Rubenstein served on the National Board of Management 2018-2020.

### **State and Chapter Service**

Terry joined the Valley of Fire Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution Las Vegas, Nevada in 2010, serving as Chapter Vice Regent before becoming the Organizing Chapter Regent, Red Rock Canyon Chapter in 2014.

Terry has served as Nevada State Regent, Vice Regent; Recording Secretary; Flag of the United States of America Committee Chair; and Membership Vice Chair, Page Chair and also Conference Co-Chair for three administrations.

She served as State Americanism Chair for six years, where she partnered with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Service and successfully petitioned the court to allow the Nevada Daughters to take part in the naturalization court proceedings.

As Vice Regent, she successfully rolled out the Nevada State Courses as Coordinator winning National recognition for participation. Terry headed a successful fundraising effort for the Nevada Junior Doll being presented at Continental Congress 2020.

As Regent, Terry's administration theme "Making a Difference Through Acts of Kindness" supports her State Regent's Project of aiding Project 150, a locally based 501(c)3 non-profit, which provides support and services to over 20,000 homeless high school students in Nevada so they can remain in school. Her State Regent's Project also financed three scholarships totaling twenty-five hundred dollars.

Terry adapted and rolled out the Nevada State Application Team, developed a training manual for state officers and chapter regents, grew membership 8%, and organized two new chapters. Won National recognition for state Sustaining Supporter participation.

After attending Hendrix College, in Conway Arkansas Terry Rubenstein was a District Training Store Manager for major specialty retailing companies, overseeing multiple brands. She was awarded a top achievement award each year from 2004-2007 before retiring.

In her spare time, Terry mentors high school students through the Academy of Finance at Ed W. Clark High School and is involved with the Clark County Law Foundation's Let Freedom Ring Committee, dedicated to providing community service programs throughout Southern Nevada that are combined with law-related education.

Terry is also involved in five other lineage societies, and currently holds board positions in two.

Terry and her husband, Bernard (Bud) of 38 years have resided in Indiana, the greater Chicago area, and Florida before moving to Las Vegas, Nevada in 1990. They attend services at Congregation Ner Tamid, have five grandchildren, and three great grandchildren.
