### **NATIONAL SERVICE**

As State Regent, Carole serves on the National Board of Management. She served as National Vice Chair DAR Scholarship for the Michael and Mary Cloyd Scholarship (2008-2013) and National Vice Chair, Property Beautification & Hospitality Committee, State Regents' Dinners (2018-2019). She currently serves as the State Regents' Club Recording Secretary and is a member of the State Vice Regents' and National Vice Chairmen's Clubs. At Continental Congress, she has served on the Platform and House Tiers Committees. Carole is a Life Member, Heritage Club Ruby Level, and Sustaining Supporter. She is a Crossnore School Trustee and participated in the Hillside School Visit and the 2019 DAR Schools Tour. She is a volunteer genealogist and field genealogist.

### **STATE and CHAPTER SERVICE**

Carole's state offices are: State Regent (2018-2021): State Vice Regent (2015-2018): State Organizing Secretary (2012-2015): and District IX Director (2009-2012), encouraging 16 chapters' officers. State chairs held are; Genealogical Records Chair (2003-2006): Lineage Research Chair (2009-2012): Membership Chair (2006-2009): Chair of the Chapter Development and Revitalization Commission (2009-2012) and State Conference Chair (2009). She has raised \$40,000 for improvements to Constitution Hall and over \$30,000 for female residences' naming rights supporting the Veterans Life Center. She transitioned state conference and Fall Forums to online registration.

She served as Chapter Regent (2002-2004) and was elected the 82-year-old chapter's first Honorary Regent. She served as Vice Regent (2000-2002), Registrar two terms (1998-2000) (2006-2008) and many committee chairs. She held a dinner/auction raising \$16,000 for Constitution programs in schools, preserved a 1766 *London Chronicle*, and created a student activity booklet for Constitution Week.

Carole is a UNC-Wilmington graduate who taught 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> grade Math laboratory. Carole served as State President of the NC Society Dames of the Court of Honor and is currently a National Trustee: Chapter President, Colonial Dames of the 17<sup>th</sup> Century; President of the Old New Hanover Genealogical Society; and holds membership in US Daughters of the War of 1812, Daughters of Colonial Wars, Daughters of American Colonists, Order of First Families of NC, American Friends of Lafayette, and the Lower Cape Fear Historical Society.
