- \_\_\_\_\_ Documentation is only required for the parent the lineage goes through.
- \_\_\_\_\_ It is appropriate to underline dates and places being used on page 2 in red pen or pencil. It is never acceptable to highlight important information with a highlighter on the source documents.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A member's National Number or an Ancestor Number is sufficient for citing a Patriot's Service on page 4 of an application.
- \_\_\_\_\_ It is perfectly appropriate to use an applicant's mother's application, especially since the mother would like her application referenced on her daughter's application, and even though more recent applications exist which provide additional and corrected information.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The DAR Electronic Application is to be filled out by the chapter registrar for the applicant.
