- \_\_\_\_\_ When submitting a typed transcription of a Bible record, it is important to correct any spelling errors in the original document, especially if a name is misspelled.
- \_\_\_\_\_ It is encouraged to include photographs of family members who owned the Bible or are mentioned in the Bible when submitting the Bible record to DAR.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Before submitting a compiled set of Bible records to the NSDAR Genealogical Records Committee, your chapter or state must first compile a complete volume of 100 pages of Bible records.
