AMERICAN HERITAGE COMMITTEE WOMEN IN THE ARTS RECOGNITION AWARD APPLICATION

The Women in the Arts Recognition Award is available for DAR members and non-members and is designed to recognize worthy women at the community level for outstanding achievements in the non-performance arts. These include fiber arts design and creation, fine arts and sculpture design and creation, music composition, literature and drama authorship, jewelry, photography and artisan design and creation including, but not limited to, metalwork, decorative painting, and pottery. The recipient is expected to have contributed to her artistic field in an outstanding manner beyond mastery of technique. This may include innovative design work, featured exhibitions, publication, research, and technique development. Professional women in the arts are eligible for this award as long as they have demonstrated outstanding contributions to their field as outlined above.

- One page description of reasons for recommending this individual.
- Two letters of recommendation written by non-DAR members on letterhead stationery identifying why the writer is professionally qualified to evaluate the candidate and include contact information.
- One to two articles which discuss the accomplishments of the individual.
- Up to five pictures, scores for music composition, or copies of the literature or drama which show the accomplishments of the individual.

Applications and instructions can be found on website or NIP. All chapters/organizations will be notified of the outcome of their application. No application packets will be returned.

APPROVAL PROCESS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE A PIN AND CERTIFICATE ARE ORDERED.

Following the approval of the recommendation by the National Vice Chair of the Women in the Arts Recognition Award, the approval form will be returned to your state society or chapter. Upon receipt of the approval form, the pin and certificate may be purchased from the DAR Store: see website "Committees-Awards and Supplies", Women in the Arts Recognition Award Pin & Certificate for \$10. The purchase is a two-step process and requires preauthorization before it can be shipped.

- 1. Place your order.
- 2. Email customerservice@dar.org a copy of your approved application or authorization form along with your order number.

Once your email has been received and verified with your order number, the order will be shipped. Since your application is approved under the current administration, it is important that you request the pin and certificate at least 8 weeks prior to the end of the administration.
