Checklist:

- 1 Letter giving family history, financial status, and education objectives.
- 2. Official copy of last semester transcript, or last transcript obtained must be sent with the application and cannot be emailed separately.
- 3. Three letters of recommendation from persons such as teachers, clergy, or others who have personally known applicant for a minimum of two years.
- 4. Proof of American Indian blood as indicated by one of the following:
 - a. A card issued by a Tribal Council
 - b. A letter from the Tribal Council

NOTE: GPA 3.25 required, based on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent. No ACT or SAT scores are required.

The terms under which the scholarship is set up specify that all checks are sent directly to the recipient's school for use in defraying expenses such as tuition and fees. Applications are due **February 15 midnight EST**.

All information must be included on the application or it will not be accepted. Applications must be emailed to the National Vice Chair at the address shown above.

Application must be typed or computer generated. Only fully executed applications, submitted in one email package, will be considered. Incomplete applications will be discarded. The National Vice Chair will notify applicants of receipt of the applications by email. Applications must be emailed to the National Vice Chair at the email address listed above. ONLY SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS are notified of the judge's decisions following the approval by the Executive Committee. Scholarship applicants selected as finalists will be contacted to provide a sealed official transcript, which will be sent to NSDAR Headquarters. Scholarships must be used within one year of award, or it will be forfeited.
