DAR SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE APPLICATION

Lillian and Arthur Dunn Scholarship (DAR Dependent)

Two scholarships of \$2,500 award each, renewable for up to four consecutive years, to students who are the sons or daughters of dues paying members of NSDAR. Outstanding students may resubmit a complete Application for consideration of each year of graduate study for an additional period up to four years of continuous study. Renewal is conditional upon maintenance of a GPA of 3.25 based on a scale or the equivalent GPA on a scale used by the applicable educational institution. This scholarship is renewable only after review and approval of the annual official transcript. Renewal transcript must be submitted to the Office of the Reporter General by July 1 of the year of renewal or the scholarship is forfeited. The mother must be a current, dues-paying member of NSDAR. Her DAR number must be on the Application.

Use the DAR Scholarship Checklist to ensure your scholarship packet is complete and is emailed to the National Vice Chair in a single email no later than February 15, 2019 Midnight EST.
